

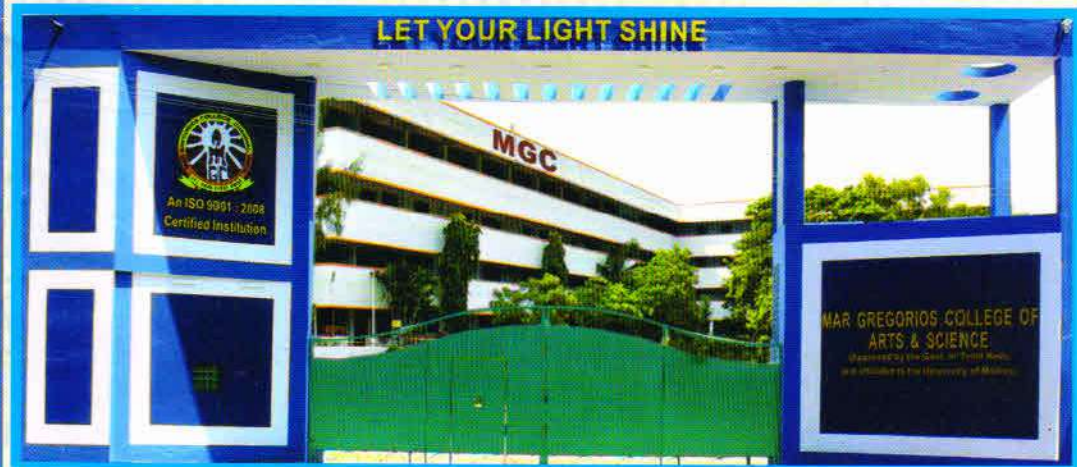

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Applications can be bought directly from the college office on payment of Rs.300/- for UG courses and Rs.350/- for PG courses. Applications can also be downloaded from our website and sent along with DD in favour of "Mar Gregorios College" payable at Chennai for the respective courses. All applications are to be addressed to "The Principal, Mar Gregorios College, Block No.8, Mogappair West, Chennai-37".

The following documents shall be submitted along with the application:

- 1) Photocopy of **twelfth mark sheet**
- 2) Photocopy of the **transfer certificate** from the previous institution
- 3) Photocopy of the **conduct certificate** issued by the institution last attended
- 4) Six latest passport size colour photographs with a **CD containing soft copy** of the passport size size with white back ground (American Visa size)
- 5) Photocopy of the **community certificate**
- 6) Migration certificate/eligibility certificate (if applicable)
- 7) At the time of interview all original certificates need to be produced.

Foreign nationals need to submit the following documents in addition to the above mentioned documents:

- 1) Photocopy of passport
- 2) Photocopy of visa
- 3) Residence proof

Foreign students should obtain the Eligibility Certificate from the

University of Madras and a No Objection Certificate from the Foreign Students Advisor and send a copy of it along with the application form to be considered for admission. Admission granted to overseas students will be provisional until they obtain Student's Visa.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE REJECTED.

Please Note: Candidates are advised to keep with them enough number of attested copies

A candidate once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same. If the candidate withdraws from the college, he/she will be liable to pay the entire fee for the course.

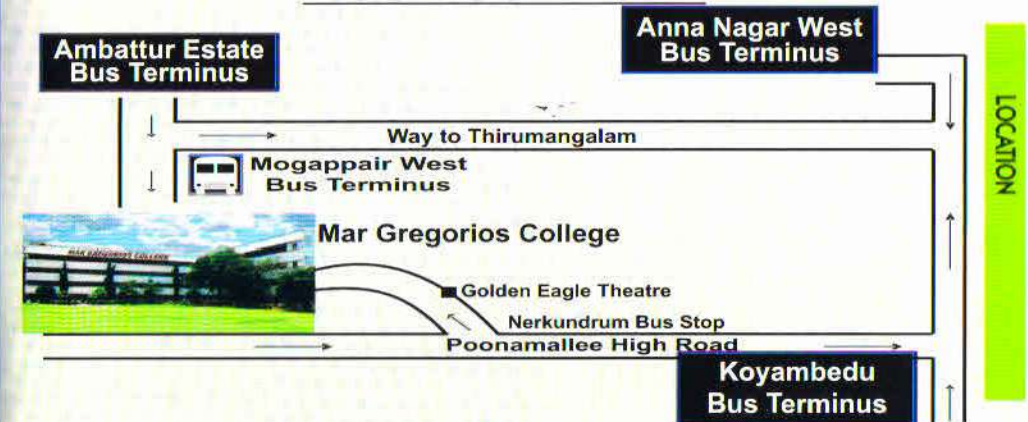
GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

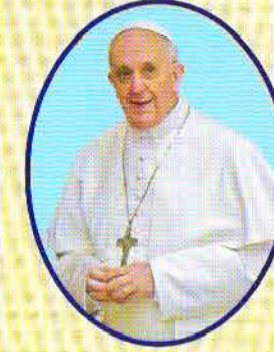

Submission of the original copies of the Transfer Certificate, 12th Mark Statement, and Conduct Certificate issued by the institution last attended are mandatory and photocopies of Aadhaar Card, Community Certificate, Migration Certificate/Eligibility Certificate (if applicable) at the time of admission. And for PG courses, UG Mark Statements and Provisional/Degree Certificate.
8. Overseas Candidates must submit photocopies of the Passport and Visa, proof of Residence in addition to the above documents. Overseas Candidates have to obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras, No Objection Certificate from the Advisor of Foreign Students, which must be attached to the application form for admission to be considered. The admission is confirmed only after the submission of the Student's Visa from the Embassy.
9. The candidate applying for UG Courses has to be accompanied by the parent/guardian for admission.
10. The admission will be confirmed after the submission of the original documents and the payment of fees. FEES will not be REFUNDED after admission.

WITHDRAWAL:

A candidate once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same. If the candidate withdraws the admission, he/she will be liable to pay the entire fee of the course.
