#### RFID IN LIBRARY

- Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) is a technology that facilitates non line of sight identification of items. Basic elements of a comprehensive RFID system for library kind of environment are Tags, Readers & Library management system
- Implementing RFID system in libraries will aid tasks such as circulation, re-shelving & theft detection, and it has several other important advantages.
- It can either replace or supplement existing library bar code system. When the costs of labour is taken into consideration for tasks such as checkout, check-in, inventory holds, lists, mis-shelved items, etc., RFID can prove to be very efficient when compared to traditional bar codes.



- In short RFID streamlines workflow in the area of self service, books return, shelf management and inventory

#### ADVANTAGES OF RFID TECHNOLOGY

##### Libraries

###### Stock management

- Operations such as managing materials on the shelves, finding items that are missing and identifying mis shelved items are streamlined and taking stocks regularly will be feasible

###### Improved patron services

- Spending minimal time on circulation operations allows library staff to assist patrons
- Routine patron services are not disturbed even when libraries are facing staff shortages & budget cuts

###### Flexibility and modularity

- Ability to add newer products and features as finances and customer needs dictate
- Expenses of adopting the technology can be managed over a time period
- Allows for phased funding and more effective use of Institutional budgets

###### Security

- Library item identification & security bit is combined into a single tag, there by eliminating the need to attach an additional security strip, hence minimizing labeling time & its associated cost.
- Security bit is automatically deactivated & reactivated as materials are checked out and in; hence no separate security procedures are required

##### Library Staff

###### Less time needed for circulation operations

- Implementing RFID will considerably reduce the amount of time required to issue, receive, transport, sort & shelve library materials
- Automated check in will reduce staff time required for material handling

###### Efficient Inventory management

- Inventory management can be done using a handheld reader without closing the library and is at least 20 times faster compared to existing barcode based system

###### Reducing Repetitive Stress Injuries (RSI)

- RFID based system reduces repetitive scanning of individual items at the circulation desk during check in, check out and hence avoids RSI such as carpal tunnel syndrome
- Taking inventory in a rfid based system doesn't require physical deshelfing & shelving of library materials

##### Patrons

- Patrons will spend less time waiting in check-out lines by using Self Check in - Check out systems
- Patrons find what they are looking for quickly & easily
- Reminders for due dates allows patrons to submit borrowed materials in time
- Use of book drops & return chutes for returning library material, allows for flexible timings
- RFID enabled patron cards allows for easy patron identification

##### Benefits of RFID over Barcode based system

- Non line of sight reading of multiple items at a time provides for efficient circulation of library materials.
- Locating specific items on shelves is possible using RFID based handheld readers.
- RFID based systems can be easily integrated with automated material handling (AMH) units to read moving items.
- On chip data storage & reprogrammable memory allows rfid tags to record information such as location of books in the library, statistics, etc.
- Auto Detection of unauthorized items going out of the library premises is possible using rfid based system.
- RFID based system can be used in harsh environment.

**Procurement of Hardware**

Sourcing of RFID hardware i.e. Readers, Tags & Antenna needs to be done before starting anything else. Once the hardware specification and respective products are finalized, specific read regions can be decided and implementation can be done.

**Tagging Books**

Each & every book needs to be tagged. The process needs 2-3 people continuously affixing tags to specific area on the books as decided earlier from the findings during the pilot test.

**Integrating Middleware**

Integrating RapidRadio's middleware with the present LMS and testing the results for improvements and errors.

**Performing Test Cases**

Predefined set of test cases will be performed in scenario based format to examine unit level and system level performance for accuracy and greater throughput.

**Training Staff**

This part of the implementation will include training staff on various aspects of RFID Technology and the new system in place. There will be a demo & training session that will include all the processes in the system.

**Process Improvement**

The errors and improvements found out from the test cases will be revisited to optimize system performance.

### PRODUCT OVERVIEW



#### Gate Detection System (RRHFGA2/GA3):

RRHFGA2 is ISO-15693 compliant walk through gate detection system capable of detecting unauthorized tagged items passing through it. It has inbuilt audio visual alert facility for theft detection and a minimum read range of 36 inches.



#### Staff Circulation Station (RRHFLB03):

RRHFLB03 is a plug n play multi protocol antenna-reader system specially designed for library circulation desk application. With a read range up to 25 cm it can be used for entry of new books or borrowers and issue/return of books at circulation desk.



#### Self Check in / Check out Kiosk (RRHFLB02):

RRHFLB02 is a stand alone multi protocol Self Check-in / Check-out kiosk primarily for self issue and return of books in Library. With its inbuilt screen and printer, patrons can view & print transaction related information such as number of books issued, outstanding fine (if any) etc. Customized information can also be printed on the transaction slip.



#### Book Return Station (RRHFBD01):

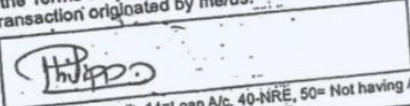
