




1. PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR WOMEN

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


2. INSTALLATION OF YOUTH UNITE - PROJECT, SEPTEMBER 2018

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
3. GENDER EQUITY PROGRAMME: AVATAR-PUTHRI, SEPTEMBER 2018

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
4. COMPETITIONS FOR WOMEN STUDENTS, AUGUST 2019


5. <u>SEMINAR ON "WOMEN EMPOWERMENT", AUGUST 2019</u>

In commemoration of the 'World Tobacco Day and World Menstrual Hygiene Day', the Department of Social Work in collaboration with Sundaram Foundation-Can Stoporganized a webinar on **28th May, 2020.** The Resource persons were Dr. Ashok [Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon], Dr. Suba Shree Ilangon and Mr. Arun Kumar.D, Asst. Professor, Department of Social Work.Nearly 60 faculty members and students participated in this webinar.The session was then taken over by Dr. ASHOK (Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon). He explained oral cancer, causes, effect, tobacco usage, and its impact on the health of the persons who consume it and others. He then explained the signs and symptoms of oral cancer and the oral cytology. The speaker highlighted how alcohol can cause 7 types of cancer affecting the mouth, the upper throat, the larynx, the esophagus, the breast in women, the liver, and the bowel. He also explained various preventive measures and treatment methods. At the end of Dr. Ashok's presentation, the share in the doctor clarified their doubts. Then DR. SUBA SHREE ILLANGOVAN explained about the menstrual hygiene maintenance of women. Both the sessions were informative and interactive.
