



REPORT ON COUNSELLING, ACADEMIC YEAR, 2017-2018.

Counselling and Guidance are inevitable in the society. When a person endures in complicated life issues, the current business trends with competitiveness develop personal mental stresses. Guidance and counselling is focused and dealt in the areas of education, personal and business. The developed society has multiple career options hence the confusion in selection of the right educational course is often confusing. Counselling and guidance helps the person to identify their own personal skill sets, hence leading to right career identification. The Guidance helps in availing the right job, as the current job scarcity affects most. Hence counselling comes handy in motivating to find the right job. The competitive environment usually leads people into unhealthy competition and negative mind frames. Guidance and counselling support people to shed unhealthy competition and leading them in right direction.

PURPOSE

The human acts generally depend on the emotions which play a vital role in every action. The immense potential of a person can be brought out with the support of proper hand holdings, effecting the person to excel in life and also assists in handling complicated issues resulting in peaceful coexistence. Students are made to understand in bridging the harmony between them and the teachers, parents resulting in building a model society. Students are made to understand their strength and weakness, also guiding in self realisation and motivating them to shape their characteristics and are taught to handle life in their stressful times.

COMMON DIAGNOSIS IN THE CAMPUS

The usual problems are classified in to 6 types:

PATHOLOGICAL PROBLEMS

Such as Inferiority complex, mood changes sleep problems, anxiety, fear, conduct disorder, personality problems, and suicidal tendency. Students who are of the above mentioned characteristics during the counselling sessions are assured of confidentiality, assuring the secrecy thus resulting in open counselling, help the students to reveal all the personal problems.

People with suicidal tendencies are brought out of the negativity by helping them to realise the gift of life and handholding them to understand life in its fullness.

ACADEMIC PROBLEMS

Academic problems such as slow Learners, memorizing difficulties, lack of concentration, lack of interest in studies, learning disability, career problems. On counselling the students with the above mentioned characteristics, we were able to bring complete transformations. During the procedures, students gained confidence. Most of the students approach with lack of sleep issues, on counselling they reveal their personal bad habits. Some are in to wrong relationships; few are even abused sexually by their own friends.

The cases are handled with utmost care as students have close relationship with their friends who guide them to shed the evil ways of life. On critical cases their parents are involved in the scenes.

The end results are promising as the academic scores of the victim students are better. The parents provide positive testimonials on the good changes in their wards. Hence counselling and guidance help to create good humans to the institution and the society.

Classical examples is of about five students who were initially scoring well in academics and later started declining in academics and were visible in to bad relationships, drugs, alcoholism and suicidal symptoms were brought for counselling, and the therapy was exercised to them for a short stipulated period. The parents of the victim students were also involved in counselling. The peace was restored in the family at the end of the procedure, resulting in tremendous positive changes in the students.

The next sect of Counselling is administered to Teachers who discriminate the students resulting in damaging the self confidence of the students. The procedure resulted with visible changes in the behaviour of the Teachers. As a result the other colleagues who were a part of the said Teachers felt the behavioural difference and personally thanked for the support system.

The Students with financial constraints were assisted with reduction in academic fee structures. They were directed to take up part time Jobs to support themselves financially.

The Parents who inappropriately dealt with their children like verbal abuse or comparing with their peer group were counselled and the changes in the parents and students were satisfactory.

For instance, there were cases where parents never wanted to support their children in buying them mobile phones or laptops or cameras. Those parents were met and discussed on the basic requisites of the students. As a result, the parents started supporting their children with required gadgets. All of which resulted as a surprise when the students won many accolades including inter-college fests.

SEXUAL PROBLEMS

A few sexual problems the students face are as follows:

- HOMO SEXUALITY
- MASTURBATION
- INDECENT VIDEOS
- SEXUAL ABUSES
- BAD RELATIONSHIPS.

These are the common issues faced by students. The issues erupts through friends circles, and has become a part and parcel of the lifestyle. The porn videos are circulated commonly among the friends groups. It becomes addictive in nature.

One of the case studies is as follows:

A student turned up for counselling and guidance as he was suffering from lack of sleep. On detailed discussion it was revealed that he is into a relationship with a girl, but she was not true to him and used to take away money from him. Upon realisation, the boy tried to cut his wrist nerve to kill himself but failed as he was given medical assistance through friends. He was given assistance to come out of the negativity and through more dialogues and therapy, we were able to bring him to normalcy. The parents were also involved in the procedures.

During the procedures his personal mobile phones were examined and found loads of videos with explicit contents, all of such were deleted from his mobile phone. His Mobile phone was kept in the office for about 10 days as a part of cure procedure, so as to make him reduce the use of the same. As a result his mobile phone usage has reduced. He stopped wandering with bad companions. We were able to make him realise that the Almighty has better future plan for him. He also opted to work part time and also took up swimming classes, in order to utilise the time available wisely. The most important thing was that he was able to forgive and forget the girl who cheated him.

BEHAVIOURAL PROBLEMS

The Behavioural problems faced usually are as follows:

- Stealing
- Lying
- Negative Mannerism
- Lack of discipline
- Lack of attendance in class
- Addiction to Games
- Addiction to Chatting
- Use of Pan masala

The Sect of people with the above characteristics usually exhibit negativity. They are unable to take things positively. Moreover they tend to spread negativity to others. The ultimate aim was to bring the students with the above characteristics to normalcy, thus enriching and elevating them in life. A decent number of students were counselled and underwent the therapy, the result was satisfactory. As there was an increase in academic scores and behavioural changes.

SOCIAL PROBLEMS

The causes for the social problems involve use of Drugs, Smoking, Alcoholism, Child abuse etc. Some sect of teachers and students were affected with the mentioned addictions. The addictions usually lead to misbehaviour with the peers and the society. The Students tend to disrespect elders, teachers and parents. It causes unnecessary conflicts and enmity leading to prolonged quarrels. The students usually skip the classes and resort in cinema halls, parks or beaches. The Teachers with similar traits often insults students, when done publicly stirs anger in students. The side effects of such insults in students at times affect their future and career as well. There are instances of Teachers not permitting students to appear for the exams. The victims were counselled and post the therapy the cure is visible.

As there's a case of a person who was smoking over 24 cigarettes every day on completion of the procedures was able to shed the habit gradually. It was followed up until the habit is cured for good.

FAMILY PROBLEMS

The society faces few family problems are as follows:

- Lack of Love and Affection
- Poverty
- Parental Problems
- Separations
- Divorced
- Adjustment Issues
- Physical Abuse


The common intolerance in the family among the parents leads to mental stress in children and they are affected psychologically. The Parents do not spend quality time with the children, primarily due to the work cultures and stress levels. Some Parents are even addicted to TV Serials, hence not taking care of the children. Poverty also causes family conflicts, due to lack of resources to run the family.

The Therapy helps in parents to realise the importance of them in their children lives. Better jobs are directed to those who were in extreme poverty levels. Expense management sessions were administered.

SUMMARY
