WITHDRAWAL:


A candidate once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same. If the candidate withdraws from the college, he/she will be liable to pay the entire fee for the course.

And for PG courses, UG Mark Statements and Provisional/Degree Certificate.
- Overseas Candidates must submit photocopies of the Passport and Visa, proof of Residence in addition to the above documents. Overseas Candidates have to obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras, No Objection Certificate from the Advisor of Foreign Students, which must be attached to the application form for admission to be considered. The admission is confirmed only after the submission of the Student's Visa from the Embassy.
- The candidate applying for UG Courses has to be accompanied by the parent/guardian for admission.
- 10. The admission will be confirmed after the submission of the original documents and the payment of fees. FEES will not be REFUNDED after admission.
