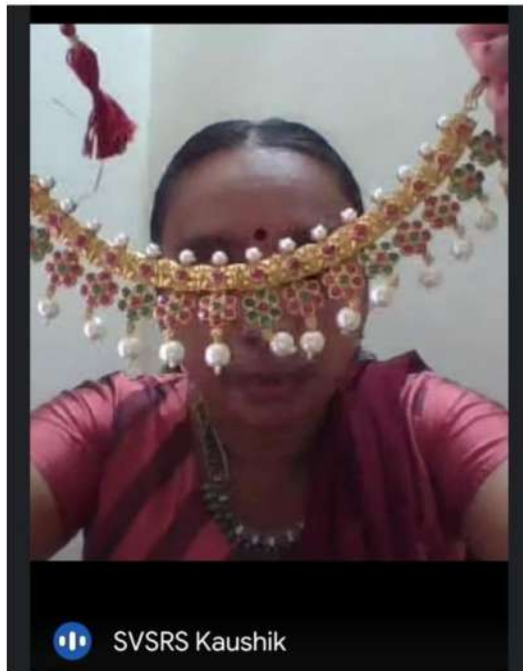
The program was concluded with vote of thanks by **Rebecca.P.A** of II BES.

REPORT

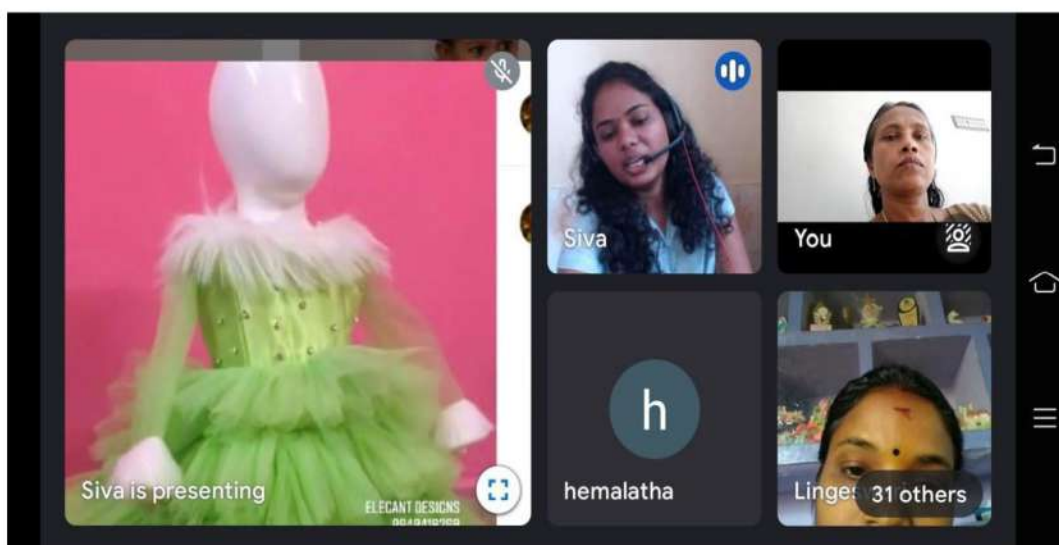

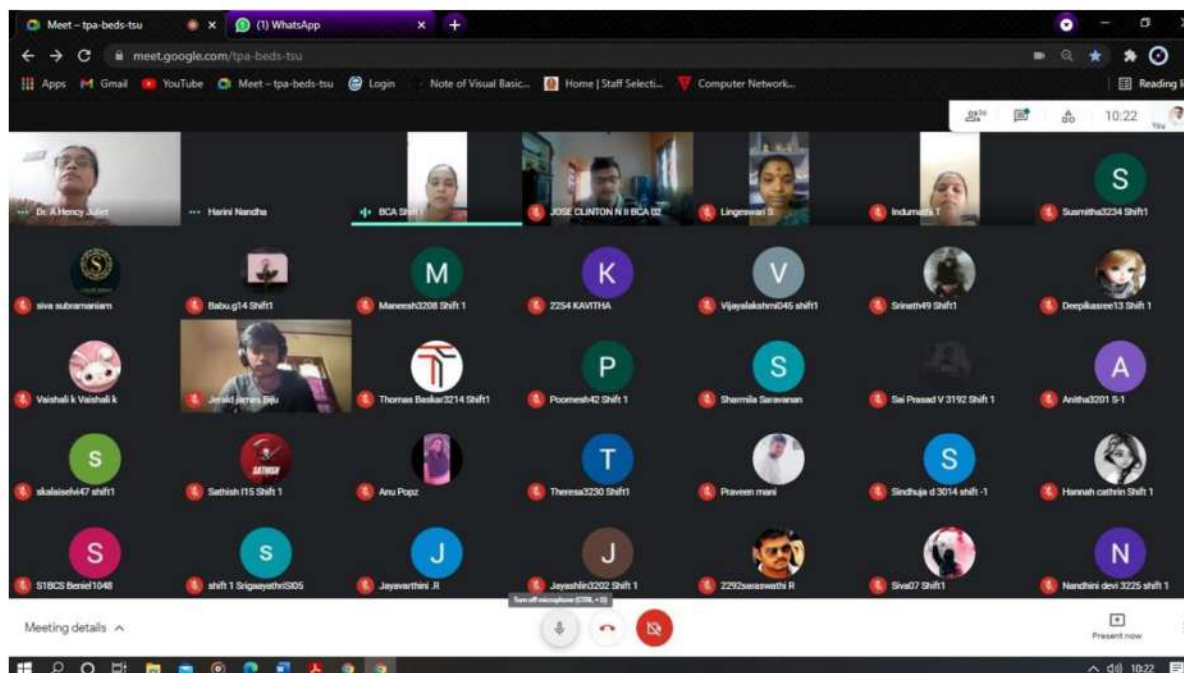
